Congratulations to all of our student athletes and coaches for another successful year!

The 2010-11 athletic season brought about many of the same challenges we had experienced in previous years including competing against much larger schools than ours. Through it all, our teams and athletes competed to the best of their ability and represented Beacon with pride and dignity.

Many of our athletes set personal, school and county records. This year our athletic program produced; 2 NCAA Division One Scholarship athletes and 1 Division II Scholarship athlete. Four athletes represented Beacon in the NYS Championships. Three of those athletes placed in the top three in the state. We had numerous All League, All County and All Section Athletes. The common thread between all of these exceptional athletes is their success in the classroom and their dedication and commitment to year round training.

Currently, Beacon High School has over 30 former athletes competing at the collegiate level. Approximately ten of those athletes are on full or partial scholarships. BOWEN WINS A NYS CHAMPIONSHIP, ALEXANDER 2ND IN TWO EVENTS

Alex Bowen won the high jump with a height of 6 feet—8 inches to win a NYS Spring Track Championship. Alex became Beacon's eighth state track and field champion. Alex also placed sixteenth in the triple jump. The University of Albany bound senior was a runner-up in the winter NYS track championships.

Tori Alexander was a runner up in the 100 and 200 meter dashes. She also placed 14th in the long jump. The Northeastern University bound senior has won ten medals in the NYS Winter and Spring Track Championships through out her career. Tori was named as the female Section One Sportsmanship winner at the state championships.

Domonique Peterson place 9th in the shot put at the NYS championships and as a junior will be returning next year.



THREE ATHLETES QUALIFY FOR THE NYSPHSAA SPRING TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Seniors, Alex Bowen and Tori Alexander and junior, Domonique Peterson qualified for the NYSPHSAA Spring Track and Field Championships at Caledonia-Mumford High School on June 10 and 11.

Alex won the the Section One high jump and triple jump events to qualify for the state championships. Poughkeepsie Journal Winter Track Athlete of the Year, Tori Alexander won the 100 meter dash and placed second in the 200 meter dash and the long jump. She qualified for the states in all three events. Domonique Peterson qualified for the state championships in the shot put and will be competing for the first time in the NYSPHSAA championships.

Bowen and Wood Sign NCAA Scholarships

Alex Bowen's ability to high jump earned him a full scholarship to Division II, University of Albany. Alex only began high jumping as a junior and this year reached a height of 6 feet 10 inches. Alex qualified for the NYS Winter and Spring Track. In the winter he placed 2nd in the state championships and 7th in the nationals.

Shaylyn Wood signed a partial softball scholarship to Division II, University of East Stroudsburg. Shaylyn was a four year starter on the varsity softball team, where she pitched and played the infield. Shaylyn has earned All League and All Section honors throughout her career on the softball team.

SPRING BASH A HUGE SUCCESS

The varsity baseball hosted the 2011 Spring Bash classic tournament over Spring Break. The tough field of 8 teams from Section 1 and Section 9 was won by Beacon. The Bulldogs defeated Section 1 champion Tappan Zee 9-5 in the first round behind the pitching of Tony Romanelli. In the semis, Beacon defeated Brewster 8-7 on a Parker Ciancanelli home run at Dutchess Stadium. In the championship game under the lights at the Dutch, Beacon defeated three time defending section 9 champion Cornwall 8-6 who was 8-0 at the time. Deondre Pierce was named to the All-tournament team and Parker Ciancanelli was named the tournament MVP.

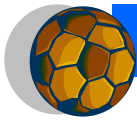
